Female applicants comprised the largest population of registrants with **55.91% (43,092)** compared to **Male** applicants with **44.09% (33,986)**.

The highest percentage of registered applicants came from the **age group 20-24** with **43.93% (33,859)**, followed by the **age group 25-34** with **25.75% (19,848)**. While the **age group 65 and above** has the least registered population with **0.26% (279)**.

Distribution of Registrants by Region

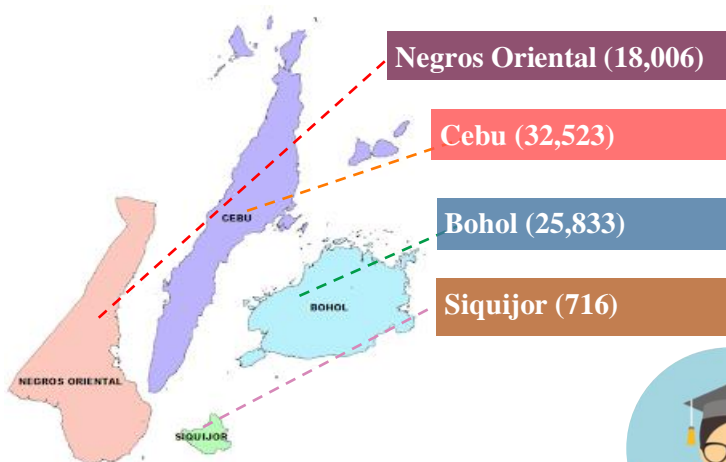

College Graduates accounted for the largest number of registrants with **21, 688 (29.66%)**, followed by **High School Graduates** with **19, 659 (26.88%)**. Majority of the **female** registrants are **College Graduates** with **31.68% (12,984)**, whereas, most of the **male** registrants are **High School Graduates** having **29.35% (9,434)** of the total male registrants.

Majority of the registrants are **unemployed** with **73.73% (34,818)**, wherein, **58.46%** of which are **female**.

Majority of the encoded registrants belonged to the **New Entrant/Fresh Graduate** group under the Unemployed category (**34,677 or 44.99%**) followed by **Wage-Employed** group under the Employed category (**12,398 or 16.08%**).

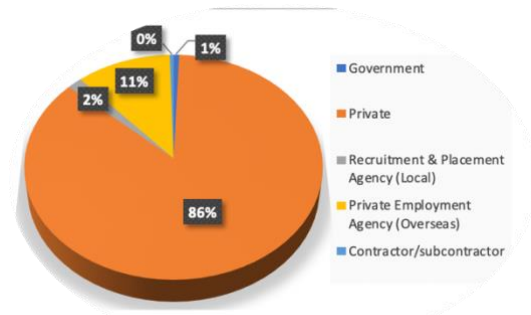
A higher percentage of **male** registrants preferred **Welder (17.41% or 207)** followed by **Electrician (12.78% or 152)**.

On the other hand, **female** registrants preferred **Production Worker (16.81% or 252)** and **Cashier (12% or 180)**.
